## COMPETITIVE "FOUR-POSITION" RIFLE PROGRAM:

Because of the present great interest in smallbore rifle shooting, and the certain tremendous increase in number of participants when the war is won, the POLICE ATHLETIC ASSOCIATION has arranged for the inception in its outdoor program this year of four Rifle Matches and one combined Rifle Tournament and Barbecue similar to the one so successfully conducted last year. Co-operating with the Association in sponsoring this rifle activity are The Puget Sound Riflemen's Council and the Seattle War Athletic Council. By popular request, a four-position, forty-shot match at fifty yards has been selected.

### GENERAL INFORMATION

TIME: Firing will commence promptly at 9:00 A.M., and relays will begin successively ON THE HOUR. Competitors must be on the line for the relay in which registered or default. Entries will be received for relays not filled, up to ONE WEEK PRECEDING EACH MATCH. (Note: Last two relays of afternoon firing reserved for Service People.)

OPEN TO: *Civilian*: Senior individuals; Junior individuals (under 19).

*Service*: Teams of Six (high four scores to count); Individuals (men and women).

ENTRY FEE: *Civilian*: Seniors \$1.50 (includes targets); Juniors 75c.

*Service*: Teams, \$3.60 per team; Individuals 60c per individual.

TROPHY AWARDS: Silver medals to winners in each classification. Additional medals proportionate to number of entries. Medals arranged for by The Puget Sound Rifleman's Council.

### CLASSIFICATION

SENIORS—Based on averages fired in 1945, Puget Sound Smallbore Rifle League Gallery season or similar leagues, as follows:

Master .....	185
Expert .....	180-185
Sharpshooter .....	171-180
Marksman under	171

Any competitor without a known average shall be classed as expert for first match excepting beginners, who have never fired in any competitive match, shall be classed as Marksman.

JUNIORS—Based on averages fired in Junior League firing or similar firing certified by their Junior Sponsor:

Expert .....	165-175
Sharpshooter .....	155-165
Marksman under	155
