Message from the Tournament Director – David Mensour,

You are cordially invited to attend the 2009 British Columbia Police Pistol Combat Championships. This will be the **37th** consecutive year that the **Law Enforcement Shooting Association** has hosted this CPCA sanctioned event. Competitors will be able to participate in the traditional PPC 1500, the Duty Pistol 1500 and we have added the new PPC 1500 Semi-Auto event. Specialty matches available are the Distinguished Revolver, Distinguished Semi-Auto and Snub-Nose Matches, as outlined in this brochure. This tournament is open to all CPCA members. The awards structure will recognize competitor performance in each individual competition. Winners will receive a trophy, plaque or certificate based on their score in each class. Snub-Nose and Distinguished Matches will be classed as “**A**” (GM & DM) “**B**” (MAS & EXP) and “**C**” (SS & MKS). At our Saturday dinner, all merchandise prizes will be awarded by a random draw ticket that is included for all our registered competitors.

The Port Coquitlam range facility has 26 shooting positions. There is limited provision for overnight camping/RV available (no hook-ups) and the washroom facilities will be open 24 hrs. **Competition Rules as per 2009 CPCA Rule Book.**

All Events PPC ,PPC S/A & Duty Pistol (1500 Events), Distinguished Revolver & Semi Auto and Snub will start on Saturday from 8am to 5pm. Range Set up only on Sept 11th, 2009

All match registrations and fees must be received by the early registration deadline August 28, 2009 for preferential squadding.

After that date you will be accommodated if possible but relay positions are limited to the number of competitors as outlined in the schedule below. The match committee will try to accommodate competitor’s squadding requests. We reserve the right to **Adjust** the number of relays based on squadding requirements.

Please do not enter Registration/Stats house once the match begins.

The Target scoring area & refreshments are located in the main clubhouse.

Social Activities & Presentations: Main Club House start 17:00 hrs approx. on Saturday, at the conclusion of competition & once challenge time has expired - Range Social (soft drinks / Munchies) – Main Club House. At approximately 18:00hrs Steak Dinner , Chicken available by pre-order only and Award Presentations .

Food/Refreshments/washrooms: Main Club House, Toast/coffee will be available from 8am-10am, Lunch 12:00 to 12:30pm. Guest steak dinners are extra @ \$20.00 ea, Chicken available by pre-order request, prize draws are for competitors only.

To register –

Use the attached entry form, which must be received no later than Aug.28, 2009. For the all-inclusive fee of **\$110.00**, the competitor can shoot **ALL OF THE EVENTS**. Pay a **\$85.00** fee & it entitles you to shoot **one** 1500 (PPC, PPC S/A or Duty Pistol) plus **one only** specialty match, either distinguished revolver or semi-auto or snub nose. Buy any extra specialty matches at a cost of **\$15.00 ea** per match should you elect to pay the minimum **\$85.00** entry fee. **Buy Extra Visitor Dinners @ \$20.00.**

All competitors must show your current 2009 CPCA classification card @ registration or you must compete in Unclassified class.

Other Useful Information – All competitors must be a current CPCA member and show current classifications card (non-classified shooters compete in Unclassified category), applications available at the registration desk, @ \$35 yr.

Courses of fire/Regulations/Equipment – As outlined per the 2009 CPCA Rule Book.

Scoring of Targets – Competitor scoring to be utilized. All scoring of targets to be done in the Main Club House ONLY.

Clothing – The range is located near the top of Burke Mountain in Coquitlam, therefore the weather can be unpredictable (rain/wind). Competitors should be prepared for all weather conditions.

Alcohol – The consumption of any alcoholic beverage on the range site is strictly prohibited. Alcohol will **NOT** be available by the match committee during the socials & evening awards presentation.

Safety & Safe Areas – Firearms may be **unboxed and holstered DISCREETLY** in the **parking lot, vehicle trunk** or in the designated safe handling area located in the **basement** of the stats office. Firearms can never be left in plain view or unattended. **Firearms may not be handled** in the parking lot or if ammunition is in the immediate vicinity. **Ammunition may be handled only when firearms are either holstered or already cased/boxed** in the parking lot, trunk of your car or safe handling area.

DRY FIRING and **Cleaning of firearms** is permitted in the Stats basement ONLY. **No Ammunition is allowed and cannot be handled in this safe area at any time.**

Location – The BC PPC Championships will be held at the Port Coquitlam & District Hunting and Fishing Club, 5000 Harper Road, Coquitlam, B.C. Travelers taking **Trans-Canada Hwy. # 1 Westbound** will cross the Port Mann Bridge, take the 1st Exit (#44) to Hwy. # 7 and follow the Port Coquitlam sign & go East towards the mountains until you arrive at Coquitlam Shopping Center & Lougheed Hwy. (# 7 East). Turn right going East and follow to Coast Meridian Rd. (Wendy's / Tim Horton). At Coast Meridian Rd. turn left and go north towards the mountains to near top of Burke Mountain (approx 3 miles) and turn right on Harper Rd. Harper Rd. will twist and wind for 1 mile, follow it to the end – through the gate and you're in the range parking lot.

Travelers using **Hwy #7 Westbound** from Maple Ridge enter into Port Coquitlam. Once you cross the Pit River Bridge continue Westbound (stay on the right side of the road). Upon reaching the intersection of Coast Meridian Road (Wendy's / Tim Horton) turn right. You will travel Northbound on Coast Meridian Road – follow directions contained above regarding Coast Meridian Rd / Harper Rd.

From the West head to Coquitlam Center. From Coquitlam Center travel East on Hwy #7 towards Maple Ridge. Turn left northbound on Coast Meridian Rd. (Wendy's & Tim Horton's) From there the directions (Coast Meridian Rd / Harper Rd) are the same as above.

Accommodations – A Best Western Hotel-POCO Inn & Suites – 604 – 941-6216 is located at the intersection of Hwy # 7 and Coast Meridian road. Several Fast Food and Family Restaurants are also located nearby. Several other local motor hotels can also be found along the Hwy # 7 route.
