

SPAA Shotgun Range

Authorization procedure for using the Electric Trap Machine

Effective Immediately, the following procedure is required for use of the Shotgun Range Electric Trap Machine.

- 1) All members desiring to use the Shotgun Range - Electric Trap machine, must Check in at the SPAA office and pick up the key.
- 2) The Electric Trap Key will be issued only to **Authorized** SPAA members with a **Trap Authorized Card**.
- 3) Member authorization is obtained by:
 - a. Complete an instructional course on the proper use of the machine.
 - b. Sign out the Key and turn over the trap authorization card, assume. Responsibility for the shooting safety and proper use of the machine while the key is assigned to the member. Return the key to the office when finished and not to other persons on the range.
 - c. Use Clay Birds obtained only from the SPAA office.
 - d. Return the key and retrieve your authorization card and sign out after shooting is completed, and report any safety or any other problems regarding the machine operation.
 - Electric Trap Machine instructional courses are given by SPAA Range personnel and have been designed to be short in duration, and easy to understand. The Schedule for these courses will be posted in the SPAA office.
